# Traffic Safety Assessment of North Portal Drive

- CLNPE formally submitted request on Feb 10, 2020 for DDOT assessment.
- Status: Pending, with overdue estimated completion date of <u>August 14, 2020</u>.
- North Portal Drive Concerns Expressed to the City:
  - Speeding.
  - High volume of suburban commuter cut-through traffic.
  - Endangered pedestrian crossings and vehicular egress from intersecting streets.
  - Endangered pedestrian travel along the entire length of North Portal Dr..
  - No all-way stop signs at 3-way intersections at:
     (1) North Portal Dr. with Tamarack St. and (2) North Portal Dr. with Birch St.
  - No crosswalks at Spruce Dr. or at East Beach Dr. (for crossing North Portal Dr).
  - Vehicles too often fail to yield to pedestrians in crosswalks at North Portal Drive's intersections.
  - Rolling stop at Spruce Drive's three-way stop sign.
  - Failure to stop and yield to traffic on East Beach Dr.
  - Vehicle speeds and blockage by commuter traffic back-ups inhibit and endanger
     North Portal Drive residents' attempts to exit their driveways.

#### Any other information you would like to share?

NPE Recommended Solutions:

- 1. Install new all-way stop signs at North Portal DR's intersections with: (a) Tamarack ST and (b) Birch DR.
- Install stop sign cameras along North Portal Drive NW.
- 3. Install speed cameras on North Portal Drive NW in both directions.
- 4. Install new pedestrian crosswalks, for crossing North Portal DR NW, at (a) Spruce DR and (b) East Beach DR.
- 5. Install in-street signs reminding drivers of the law requiring them to stop for pedestrians in crosswalks.
- 6. Install posted speed limit signs along North Portal Drive NW in both directions.
- 7. Implement rush-hour restrictions for accessing North Portal Drive NW (from 16th Street and from East Beach Drive), which limit traffic to NPE residents and visitors.

While awaiting DDOT's conduct and completion of our requested traffic safety assessment, CLNPE's Infrastructure Committee submitted the following safety-related DC 311 Service Requests for DDOT's action.




